7. Leave 1" free around the entire outside border (leave 1" white space border).
8. The words "Farmer City / DeWitt County Fair" must appear on the border of the poster (stencils are not allowed).
9. Posters may be picked up on Sunday, July 22rd, 2018, in Floral Hall from 12PM - 2PM.
10. Crayon, marker, pencil, chalk, or paint is allowed. Accent items can be glued on to create originality (no magazine or newspaper cut outs are allowed).
11. Posters can be horizontal or vertical layout.
12. Premium checks will be mailed to exhibitors upon conclusion of the fair.
