1. All entries in Junior Division, Class 1 and 2 must be in place not later than 10 am, Wednesday, July 18, 2018.
2. Judging will commence promptly at 10:30AM, Wednesday, July 18, 2018 on all Junior Division lots.
3. No exhibitors or their helpers will be allowed in the exhibit area while judging is underway.
4. Exhibitors must furnish containers for all entries and are required to keep their entries presentable during the period of the show whether or not they received awards.
5. All items in #1209 which mold during the fair, will be discarded. Tags and ribbons will be held for the exhibitor.
6. All entries in Class 1 must have been grown by the exhibitor.
7. Flowers used in Class 2 may be from any source as long as the arrangements are constructed by the exhibitor.
8. Entries are open to anyone in the State of Illinois.
9. **All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor.**
10. Juniors are allowed to enter the Open Class as long as they are showing in the Junior Class - Floriculture Show.
11. All entry blanks must be made personally or mailed to the secretary’s office to be received by Saturday, July 14, at 3PM and checked in with the superintendent on the appropriate day.
12. 2016 First Prize winning entry cannot be re-entered in the 2018 Fair.
13. No more than two entries may be made under any one premium number.
14. All exhibits must be left until Sunday, July 22, 2018 and picked up between noon and 2PM.
15. Premium checks will be mailed to exhibitors upon the conclusion of the fair.
